Antonio VALLI : Applicant for Consent under National
Security (Land Transfer) Regulations.

In reply to memorandum L.13042 of 22.11.46 from the Secretary of this Department relative to the above, I desire to advise that enquiries have been made in this respect, and the following information is submitted:

Applicant has been interviewed in this office. He advises that the property subject of his application comprises approximately 12 acres situated in Queens Park Road, Cannington, previously worked as a dairy by F. Brown. The dairy license has been withdrawn, and applicant desires to acquire the property for market gardening and poultry raising. He has resided on the property, together with his wife and children for the past month, having sold his property at Donnybrook. Purchase price is £1,890 (as amended by Delegate to Treasurer), and a deposit of \$200 has been lodged, balance to be paid in cash on receipt of consent. Applicant owns a $\frac{1}{4}$ acre block in North Beach Road, valued at about £10, and his wife does not own any property.

Applicant is not adversely recorded in this office, and it is not considered that local residents of the district would oppose the proposed transfer.
