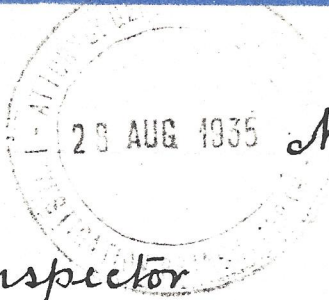

To the Inspector

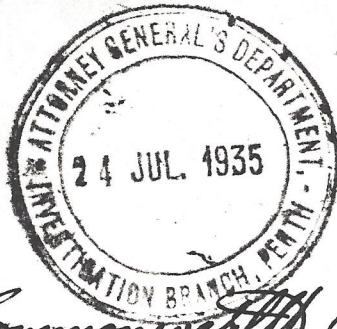
Dear Sir
