The Memorial of Joseph Tuiā of
Tahiti in the Colony of Victoria Laborer
Respectfully sheweth

1. That your Memorialist's name is Joseph Tuiā
 2. That he is fifty three years of age
 3. That he was born at Castella Aqua in Italy
 4. That he is by occupation a Laborer
 5. That on the twenty sixth day of April in the year 1862 he arrived in the Colony of Victoria by the Ship *Sussex* from the port of London in England and that he has ever since his arrival, being a period of thirty years, been a resident in the said Colony of Victoria
 6. That he is desirous of permanently settling in the said Colony, and of being naturalized therein
