CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION.

By virtue of the *Nationality Act* 1920-~~1922~~¹⁹³⁰ of the said [Commonwealth [and the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Acts 1914 to 1922 of the United Kingdom, ~~I, the Governor General~~ ^{THE PERSON ADMINISTERING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE} ~~in and over the~~ Commonwealth of Australia, certify that I have received an application supported by a Statutory Declaration, from Luigi Tuia now residing at Balingup, Western Australia hitherto an Italian citizen whose description appears in the margin, and on the faith of the statements appearing therein, and having regard to the fact that the applicant has formally renounced his allegiance to the Kingdom of Italy and has sworn allegiance to HIS MAJESTY KING GEORGE V., his heirs and successors, I, ~~the said Governor General,~~ ^{acting} with the advice of The Federal Executive Council, grant to the said Luigi Tuia this **Certificate of Naturalization** whereby, subject to the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, and of any other law affecting the rights of naturalized persons, the said Luigi Tuia becomes entitled to all POLITICAL and other RIGHTS, POWERS, and PRIVILEGES, and becomes subject to all OBLIGATIONS, DUTIES and LIABILITIES to which a NATURAL-BORN BRITISH SUBJECT is entitled or subject and, as from the date of these presents, has to all intents and purposes the status of a NATURAL-BORN BRITISH SUBJECT.
